We've experienced a tremendous fall season. **The campus** was busy with school groups, church retreats, educational learning opportunities, families and fellowship. This time

of year is also a wonderful time of reflection. In late September, I had the opportunity to update the YMCA Blue Ridge Board of Directors on how Blue Ridge was fulfilling its operational rebound plan, **RISE**. The plan was created to be an 18–24-month plan and provided the strategy screens (**R**eturn on Investment, **I**mpact, **S**ustainable, **E**xcellence) and priorities (Stewardship, Engaged & Empowered Staff, Efficient Operations) for filtering and making decisions.

Here are a few highlights: **Most importantly, the staff are dedicated, servant leaders!** The rate of change we are experiencing is astounding – 120% group and 234% guest growth since 2020. We are forecasting an overall financial return of about 78% in 2022. It is working, and **we are hopeful to realize a 100% return by year-end 2023.**




